



SNT Half Year report

In this document, the new board would like to quickly reflect on the first half of 2025

1. Member flow

As is tradition at this point, the inflow of members has been limited, although the lunches are usually well-visited. Having accessible tasks for new students is still an issue. Some member-recruitment posters were hung up a while ago, although they resulted more in customers than members. We still intend to keep up a steady amount of advertising. This includes the upcoming kick-in, where we will have a stand again. Ideas are welcome.

2. LISA

Current LISA collaboration seem to be quite positive. Meetings with Rene (head ITO) have been going well. The UT is also cautiously optimistic about their finances again. We expect the budget for 2026 to end up at 12.5k again, instead of the previously suggested 10k. This can still change however. LISA is expecting to hire for many positions in the coming years, and is working with SNT to see where we can help.

3. Rent

Discussions with the SU on lowering rent have gotten stuck. While the rent has gone down slightly in 2024, we still pay the highest rent of all associations. Given the SU's financial situation and their unwillingness to care about associations, we do not expect much progress until a new board arrives there.

4. Lustrum

We had a nice Lustrum reünion event. This was very well received by many old members.

5. Servers

The board would still like to replace some more very old servers, and has allocated a budget for this for both 2025 and 2026. This has already been partially used, but more budget is available.
